Results Of BIG IoT Open Call 2 for recipients of financial support

Project BIG IoT, co-funded from the European Union’s Horizon 2020 Research and Innovation programme under grant agreement No 688038, launched on January 30th 2017 an open call (call ID ref. BIG IoT-OC2) for recipients of financial support. The formal Open call announcement was drafted and published on the Horizon 2020 Participant Portal (<http://ec.europa.eu/research/participants/portal/desktop/en/opportunities/other/competitive.html#collapseEightyFour>) and full call details were published on the BIG IoT web site (<http://big-iot.eu/second-open-call/>).

The call closed on May 4th 2018, at 17.00 CET. A total of 39 proposals were received for this call. Eight proposals will receive funding for a total amount of 397.900 EUR.

The evaluation of proposals by External Experts and the final selection have been completed. All proposers will be informed about the evaluation results for their proposal for financial support. The negotiations and preparations of the contracts with the selected applicants will be completed within the month of June 2018.
